Designed to look like the rippling of water after throwing a stone, this bench began as an art installation in the Roppongi Hill district of Tokyo.

Indoor version (top left and above): Vegetable oil finished plywood (walnut, mahogany, cherry, oak and ash) with inner steel structure and beech covered underside.

Outdoor version (top right): Okoume' plywood with holes in the centre of the ripples.
